ADOPT-A-HOLE INFORMATION

The CP Women's Open will be an event to remember. To make this a successful championship, Golf Canada relies on the hard work and dedication of our volunteer team. Golf Canada would like to invite your club to marshal a specific hole for the championship. This is a wonderful opportunity for your members to come together and represent their golf club on both the national and international stage and have fun doing it.

Championship signage will identify your club as the official marshals of a specified hole during tournament week. Clubs will be responsible for providing volunteers from Monday to Sunday of championship week. Approximately 20 to 30 volunteers are needed for the week to cover the required shifts. Please note that volunteers are required to work at least 24 hours over a minimum of 4 days during championship week. Marshals will be required to stand for long periods of time and basic golf knowledge and etiquette are required.

All volunteers are required to pay the \$75 volunteer fee. This entitles each volunteer to a volunteer package worth over \$300 (See the volunteer section of our website for the list of great items included in your volunteer package). Other benefits included recognition of your golf club on the course and in our Volunteer Newsletter, the experience of being inside the ropes at a professional sporting event and witnessing the world's greatest female golfers compete.

Interested clubs should return the Adopt-A-Hole Intent form and distribute volunteer applications to members. One volunteer must be designated as the club representative/hole captain. The club representative will be the main contact before and during the event and should be prepared to help to recruit and/or schedule volunteers. Holes will be adopted on a first come – first served basis, based upon the number of volunteers registered, not the date we receive your Intent form. Please encourage your members to register as volunteers as soon as possible to secure a hole for your club.

How to Register:

1. Return the Adopt-A-Hole Intent Form to Golf Canada at cpwomensopen@golfcanada.ca to express your interest in participating in our Adopt-a-Hole program and designate a club representative.
2. Encourage members to register as volunteers online at www.cpwomensopen.com Encourage members to do so as soon as possible and choose Marshals as your first preference.
3. Twenty (20) volunteers are required to secure a hole. You will be confirmed as an official Adopt-a-Hole club once enough applications have been received. Remember, holes are assigned based upon the number of volunteers registered, not the date we receive your Intent Form.
